A Message From the Houston Bar Foundation Chair

Throughout this year I have had the privilege of serving as Chair of the Houston Bar Foundation. Many ask what is the Houston Bar Foundation and what does it do? As a young lawyer I asked these same questions myself.

The Houston Bar Foundation is the charitable arm of the Houston Bar Association. It is a qualified 501(c)(3) organization with, primarily, a three-fold mission:

- (1) We support legal assistance programs for low-income residents of Harris County who cannot afford to pay for legal services;
- (2) We sponsor education programs about our legal system; and
- (3) We provide assistance to our fellow attorneys who may be in need.

The Houston Bar Foundation is the primary benefactor of the Houston Volunteer Lawyers Program (“HVLP”) which provides pro bono legal services to low-income and financially disadvantaged residents of Harris County. In 2009, volunteer lawyers devoted 26,580 hours of legal services, handling 2,280 pro bono cases and providing advice and counsel to thousands more through HVLP clinics. From January through July of 2010, volunteer lawyers accepted 1,459 cases for ongoing representation and provided 13,907 hours of legal services. The types of cases handled include family law and child custody matters, probate, consumer and bankruptcy matters, social security benefits, veteran’s benefits and AIDS-related legal matters. Of particular note are the HVLP’s veteran’s clinics and the recently conducted will-a-thon for active duty military personnel about to be deployed to Afghanistan. Few of these pro bono activities could occur without the financial support of the Houston Bar Association.

In the area of education, for the 19th year, the Houston Bar Foundation is involved, in partnership with the Houston Bar Association Auxiliary Charitable Fund, with the distribution of “Now You Are 18” handbooks to Houston area high school students. These handbooks provide information about our legal system and the rule of law, as well as guidance on certain laws of general interest so that these young people will be better prepared to deal with the real world as new adults. This year approximately 25,000 of the handbooks were distributed.

As mentioned, we also help local lawyers who are in need of financial assistance. Over the years, we have assisted attorneys whose practices were victimized by hurricanes and storms. We have also provided assistance to lawyers adversely affected by health and medical problems, the need for mental or physical rehabilitation services and other family situations. The Foundation-sponsored lawyer assistance program is now in its 21st year.

How are we able to do this? The answer is simple: the financial generosity of the lawyers of Houston and the surrounding Harris County area; and careful stewardship of the funds we receive and invest.

In addition to direct contributions from individuals and firms, the Houston Bar Foundation has two other primary fundraising sources: (1) the annual Harvest Party held each November, and (2) the Fellows program. This year we raised a record \$527,500 in underwriting for the Harvest Party. This underwriting comes from the generous support of large, medium and small law firms; corporate legal departments; solo practitioners; and vendors and service providers to the legal profession. Without these funds, the activities of the HVLP would be sharply curtailed and, in some instances, would not exist at all.

Our Fellows program provides individual members of the bar with the opportunity to make a difference. It involves the commitment to make a modest, tax deductible, financial contribution of approximately \$0.55 per day, to the Houston Bar Foundation over a period of ten years. The success of our Fellows program is critical to the financial success of the Houston Bar Foundation. Without the financial support of our Fellows, the scope and reach of the Houston Bar Foundation’s charitable activities would be limited. If you are invited to become a Fellow, please give the invitation your serious consideration. We would welcome you coming on board as a Fellow of the Houston Bar Foundation.

Fellows Program Allows HBF to Support Community, Profession

The Houston Bar Foundation is now in its 28th year of service to the community and the profession. The success of the Foundation is due in large part to the commitment of HBA members, who contribute \$20 of their yearly dues to the Foundation. In addition, the Foundation has a Fellows Program that provides the opportunity for long-term giving.

The Fellows Program provides members the opportunity to increase their contributions to achieve both short-term and long-term goals for the Foundation, as well as their own charitable giving plan. This is an outline of the Fellows Program:

A. A Fellow pledges \$2,000, payable in a lump sum or \$200 per year for ten years.

B. Once the original \$2,000 commitment is met, a Fellow will have the opportunity to become a Life Fellow by continuing to donate \$200 per year for ten years or making an additional lump payment of \$2,000.

C. Once the Life Fellow commitment is met, a member may become a Sustaining Life Fellow by continuing to donate \$200 per year for 10 years or making a third lump payment of \$2,000.

D. Once the Sustaining Life Fellow commitment is met, the member may become a Continuing Sustaining Life Fellow by donating

\$200 per year for five years or making a lump payment of \$1,000.

Honorary Fellow is a distinction given from time to time to an individual who has exhibited outstanding interest in and support of the administration of justice. The designation as a Patron of the Foundation is given to entities, such as corporations, foundations or individuals, who have made substantial contributions to the administration of justice through the Houston Bar Foundation. To date, the late Joe M. Green of the Rockwell Fund is the only individual to be honored as a Patron, and Shell Oil Company is the only organization to receive that distinction.

The Houston Bar Association staff handles all administrative functions for the Houston Bar Foundation, keeping administrative costs to a minimum.

The goal of the Houston Bar Foundation is to become self-sustaining, with the ability to maintain and expand existing programs, while adding new programs as needs arise. A tax-deductible contribution to the Houston Bar Foundation is one of the best investments HBA members can make in the future of their profession and their community. Foundation Presents Inaugural James B. Sales ProBono Leadership Award

The Houston Bar Foundation presented its inaugural James B. Sales ProBono Leadership Award to the honor's namesake at the Foundation's 2010 annual luncheon on January 13. James B. Sales, senior partner at Fulbright & Jaworski L.L.P., was recognized for his outstanding contributions in the area of providing legal services to low-income Texans through a lifetime of commitment and leadership. The award will be given annually to an individual who embodies those same principles.

Sales' legal career and service to the public have spanned nearly 50 years. He is a former president of the Houston Bar Association, served as the first chair of the Houston Bar Foundation, and is a former president of the State Bar of Texas. He established some of the most enduring professionalism and community service programs in Houston and throughout Texas. Sales was the

founder of the Houston Volunteer Lawyers Program and a leader in the development of alternative dispute resolution in Houston as a founder of the Harris County Dispute Resolution Center. As chair of the Houston Bar Foundation, he was responsible for helping to develop the core philosophy and the Foundation Fellows program that today provides strategic support for the HBA's pro bono efforts.

Sales was selected as the second chair of the Texas Access to Justice Commission, established in 2001 by the Supreme Court of Texas with the support of the State Bar of Texas and civil legal services providers. He was instrumental in developing a five-year strategic plan for the commission, which has significantly enhanced direct access to justice for low-income and poor Texans. Sales chaired the Commission through May 2009.

Foundation Honors Pro Bono Service, Volunteerism with 2009 Awards

During its 2010 Annual Meeting and Luncheon, held January 13 at The Houston Club, the Houston Bar Foundation honored firms and individuals for outstanding pro bono service, volunteerism and legal writing. The keynote speaker was Pastor Kirbyjohn Caldwell of Windsor United Methodist Church.

The Foundation presents annual awards for outstanding contributions to the Houston Volunteer Lawyers Program (HVLP), for outstanding volunteer service to the Dispute Resolution Center, and for outstanding legal writing in the HBA's magazine, *The Houston Lawyer*.

The law firms of Baker Botts L.L.P. and Fulbright & Jaworski L.L.P. shared the award for Outstanding Contribution to the Houston Volunteer Lawyers Program by a Large Firm. Haynes and Boone, LLP received the award for Outstanding Contribution to the HVLP by an Intermediate Firm. Strasburger & Price, L.L.P. received the award for Outstanding Contribution to the HVLP by a Mid-size Firm. Schwartz, Junell, Greenberg & Oathout, L.L.P. received the award for Outstanding Contribution to the HVLP by a Small Firm. Marathon Oil Corporation received the award for Outstanding Contribution to HVLP by a

Corporate Law Department.

Peter Bennett was honored for Outstanding Contribution to HVLP by a solo practitioner. Peggy Montgomery of ExxonMobil Corporation earned her fourth award for Outstanding Service to the HVLP by a law firm/corporation Pro Bono Coordinator. The Foundation also presented a service award to Rafte & Company for outstanding service to HVLP in the area of IT consulting and technology services.

David Verbit, president and managing partner of David M. Verbit & Associates, was honored for Outstanding Volunteer Service to the Dispute Resolution Center, while Maria Garcia, a paralegal and CFO for Structura Design, was honored for Longevity of Exemplary Service to the Dispute Resolution Center.

Farah Martinez, director of legislative affairs for the Harris County District Clerk's Office, was honored as the author of "Wrongly Convicted: Victim of the Justice System," chosen as the outstanding legal article published during 2009-2010 in *The Houston Lawyer*, the HBA's professional journal.

Veterans' Legal Initiative Goes Statewide

The Houston Bar Foundation provides funding for the HBA Veterans' Legal Initiative, established in 2008 by then-HBA President Travis J. Sales. The Houston Bar Foundation provides funding for the initiative, which has now served over 3,400 veterans through legal advice clinics and direct legal representation.

This summer, State Bar of Texas President Terry Tottenham established a statewide veterans' initiative, Texas Lawyers for Texas Veterans, based on the HBA's program. This has resulted in the creation or expansion of pro bono clinics for veterans in all metropolitan areas of the state, including Austin, Dallas, El Paso, Fort Worth, Houston and San Antonio, as well as in smaller communities and counties such as Bastrop, Beaumont, Denton, Galveston, Fort Bend County, Northeast Harris County, and Midland-Odessa. In commemoration of Veterans Day, a number of smaller bar associations throughout the region held legal advice clinics, with HBA staff assisting them. Statewide, there were 20 legal clinics to serve veterans.

The HBA for the first time this fall served active duty military per-

sonnel about to be deployed overseas by preparing wills and estate planning documents for them. Volunteer attorneys prepared and executed the documents for nearly 90 young Marine Reservists at Ellington Field.

Programs Funded by Houston Bar Foundation in 2010

HOUSTON VOLUNTEER LAWYERS PROGRAM

The Houston Bar Foundation provides primary support for the Houston Volunteer Lawyers Program through an annual grant. The Houston Bar Association established the HVLP in 1981 to fill a critical need for legal services for those people who could not qualify for legal aid programs because they were working to support their families. In reality, however, their salaries would not cover even the most basic legal needs, such as divorce, child custody, landlord/tenant issues or probate matters. Through this program, volunteer private attorneys handle cases pro bono for eligible, low-income clients.

From January through July 2010, the HVLP screened 21,705 applicants for legal services through their Telephone Intake Hotline, Family Law Courthouse Booth and Saturday legal clinics. From the telephone screening process, 2,441 interviews were scheduled; 1,459 cases were accepted for placement, meaning that the client provided all necessary information and met the criteria for assistance. All callers received either a referral or advice regarding their legal matters. In many instances, referrals were made to other local assistance organizations because the caller did not have a legal issue that could be resolved by HVLP or they did not meet the criteria for placement with HVLP. During this time period, HVLP closed 8,244 cases, providing either counsel and advice or complete representation.

There are over 1,200 attorneys actively engaged in providing representation in a wide range of civil matters, with some attorneys working on more than one case. These attorneys have reported 13,907 volunteer hours. At the calculated rate of \$200 per hour, this represents \$2,781,400 in pro bono legal services.

The types of cases handled through HVLP include family law (divorce and child custody); property law (landlord/tenant, foreclosures, title and homestead taxation); consumer law (bankruptcy, contracts and credit, insurance, collections and repossession); tort law that is non-fee generating; probate law (wills, probate and guardianship); IRS tax controversies. Special projects coordinated by HVLP include:

• **Legal Advice Clinics** – On the first Saturday of each month, a Houston law firm or legal department volunteers to staff a clinic at various locations to provide legal advice and pro bono representation for clients from the surrounding area who attend the clinic.

• **Courthouse Information Booth** – The HVLP operates an information booth for pro se litigants in the Harris County Family Law Center on weekdays. The booth is staffed by an HVLP attorney and an intake specialist.

• **Veteran Legal Clinics** – Volunteer attorneys meet with veterans at the VA Hospital every Friday from 2:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m. to provide initial advice on a wide variety of legal matters. Volunteers also meet with low-income vets housed at US Vets Midtown Terrace and the DeGeorge at Union Station on a rotating basis following a speaker from the HBA's Speakers Bureau on a current topic. Volunteer attorneys also deliver legal services to veterans at the American Legion Post 560 Hall as a "Day of Giving" project twice yearly.

• **Drive Time Clinics** – Monthly Drive Time Clinics, held from 2:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m. and staffed by volunteer attorneys, offer clients the opportunity to get legal advice and pro bono representation at the Houston Volunteer Lawyers Program's downtown office, during convenient hours.

• **Asian Legal Clinics** – HVLP has expanded outreach to Houston's Asian community, which has traditionally been underserved by existing service organizations. Utilizing multi-lingual staff and volunteers, HVLP conducts monthly clinics targeting the Asian community at Houston's VN Teamwork.

• **Wills and Estate Planning** – HVLP volunteers assist in preparing wills and incapacity planning documents for senior citizens, persons of HIV/AIDS, and others through both traditional referrals and periodic Will Clinics.

• **Disability and Elder Law Unit** – This project, which began in 1989, provides pro bono representation for persons living with HIV/AIDS. The extensive outreach program includes meeting with clients at local clinics, hospitals, hospices, AIDS services organizations and homes of clients, if necessary.

• **Low-Income Taxpayer Clinic** – Funded in part by a grant from the IRS, the clinic matches volunteer attorneys with qualifying low-income taxpayers involved in IRS tax controversies, including audits and appeals, collection matters and representation in U.S. Tax Court.

• **Bankruptcy Program** – In conjunction with the HBA Bankruptcy Section, volunteers provide pro bono representation to eligible clients who cannot afford the legal services related to filing bankruptcy.

• **Community Development Program** – The HVLP recruits volunteer attorneys to support community development corporations and other non-profit entities serving Houston's low-income population. Assistance includes legal representation in corporate, transactional and real estate matters.

Programs Funded by Houston Bar Foundation in 2010 *continued*

In June 2006, the Houston Bar Association, the Houston Bar Foundation and the Houston Volunteer Lawyers Program embarked on a new "Equal Access Initiative" designed to increase the number of cases taken yearly from just under 1,000 to 1,500 yearly over five years. This initiative targets law firms of all sizes and corporations, engaging their support by asking them to sign a commitment form that they will handle a certain number of cases, based on the number of attorneys in the firm, each year for the next five years. Once they sign the commitment, HVLP staff forward cases to each firm's or corporation's pro bono coordinator on a regular basis, until their commitment is met. During the 2009-2010 Bar year, 2,301 cases were placed.

Over the past few years, HBA presidents have also initiated signature program including the Veteran's Initiative by President Travis Sales, the Habitat Wills Initiative by President Tommy Proctor, and the Consumer Law Task Force with a Consumer Legal Advice Clinic component by Barrett Reasoner. Each program was designed to mobilize the volunteerism of the Houston Bar Association to address pressing pro bono needs in our community.

LAWYER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The Houston Bar Foundation provides limited, temporary financial assistance to attorneys who qualify and are approved by the Foundation's Board of Directors as being in need of Financial Assistance.

CONTINUING EDUCATION GRANTS

The Foundation provides a grant to underwrite education for Harris County court personnel that is related directly to the administration of justice. Grants have been made to both individuals and groups.

JUVENILE JUSTICE MOCK TRIAL PROGRAM

The Houston Bar Association's Juvenile Justice Mock Trial Program is now in its 36th year of teaching young teens about law and the legal system. As part of social studies or history classes, students at 40 participating public and private schools in the Houston area work with law students and staff to learn about the procedures involved in a courtroom trial.

Over a five-week period, the students develop their own case story and assume the roles of judge, jurors, attorneys, defendants, plaintiffs and witnesses. At the end of the unit, the classes travel to the Harris County courthouse complex where they enact their mock trial in an actual courtroom. The program focuses on eighth grade students and has reached more than 37,000 students in the Houston area, encouraging respect for the judicial system and discouraging entry into the system in a negative way.

DOCUMENT PRESERVATION PROJECT

The Foundation partners with the Harris County District Clerk's Document Preservation Project to accept donations for preserving and cataloging historical cases and documents from the Harris County Courts. Donations to preserve specific case files or for general document preservation needs may be made through the Foundation.

'NOW YOU ARE 18' HANDBOOKS

A grant to the Houston Bar Association Auxiliary Charitable Fund enabled the HBA Auxiliary to distribute 25,500 copies of the booklet, "Now You Are 18" to high school seniors in 10 school districts and five private high schools in Harris County. Prepared by the Texas Lawyers Auxiliary, the booklet explains the importance of knowing one's legal rights and responsibilities. Topics covered include issues such as renting an apartment, credit and debt collection, employment and buying a car.
