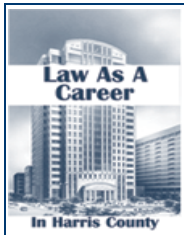
Jury Service - High School Level

Law as a Career Booklet - Grade Levels 5 - 12

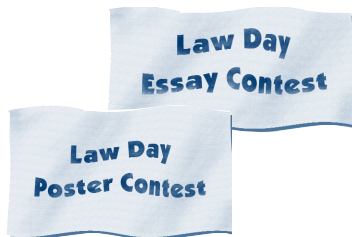
